

COE Aviation Students Win Scholarships

The Minnesota Business Aviation Association (MBAA) recently awarded over \$40,000 in scholarships, including three of four 2011 scholarships to Minnesota State Mankato aviation students:

- **Tyler Rogers**, Citation II flight simulator type rating, Awarded by CAE Simuflite (\$13,000 and a \$1000 travel stipend)
- **Brandyn Dietman**, Citation Encore flight simulator type rating, Awarded by Flight Safety International (\$21,800 and a \$1000 travel stipend)
- **Joe Sacco, \$2500** Academic/Flight training scholarship, Awarded by MBAA

Students received the awards at an evening reception in St. Paul following the MBAA scholarship golf tournament on August 29, 2011.

Flight training partner North Star Aviation sponsored a hole, on behalf of MSU, during the tournament, while student Tyler Rogers greeted golfers and shared information about the COE aviation program.
